MIXING

Mix Powdered Tile Grout at a ratio of 2 1/2 cups Tile Grout to 1 cup clean water in a clean container. Slowly add water, stirring constantly until a heavy, creamy consistency is obtained. Do not mix more than can be used in 45 minutes.

APPLICATION

Dampen entire surface using a clean, wet sponge. This will ensure proper cure of Tile Grout. To avoid skin irritation, wear rubber gloves. Force Tile Grout into crack or joint with a plastic putty knife. Smooth the area while damp and allow 30 minutes for the Tile Grout to harden. Remove excess Grout by wiping with a clean, damp cloth or sponge. Allow to cure 12 hours, polish tile with a clean, dry cloth.

Clean tools with water immediately after use.
